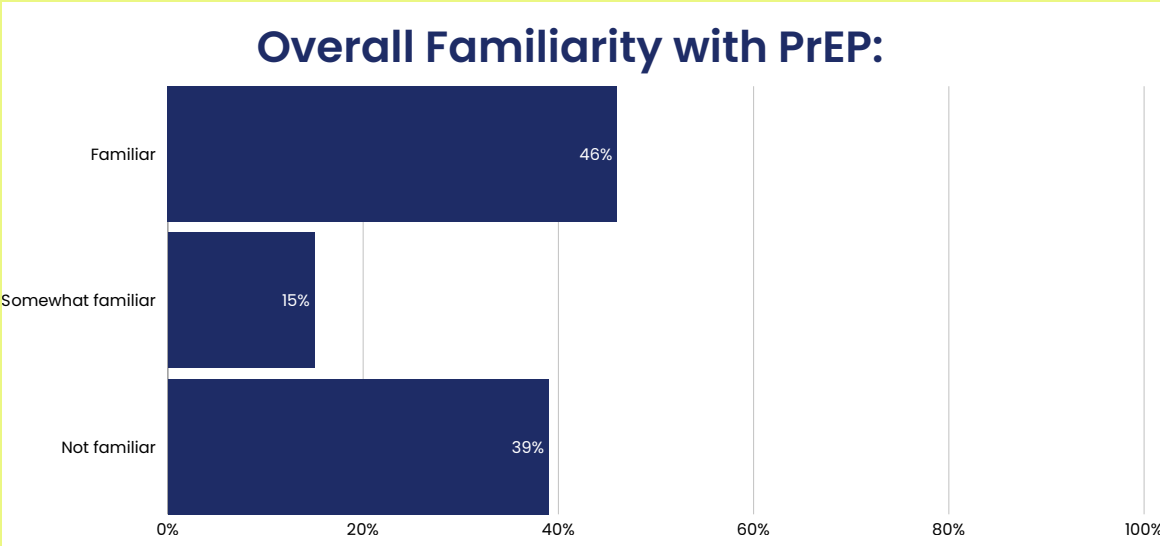


PrEP Awareness Survey Results



Overall, 46% of local residents are familiar with PrEP, the medication that prevents HIV.



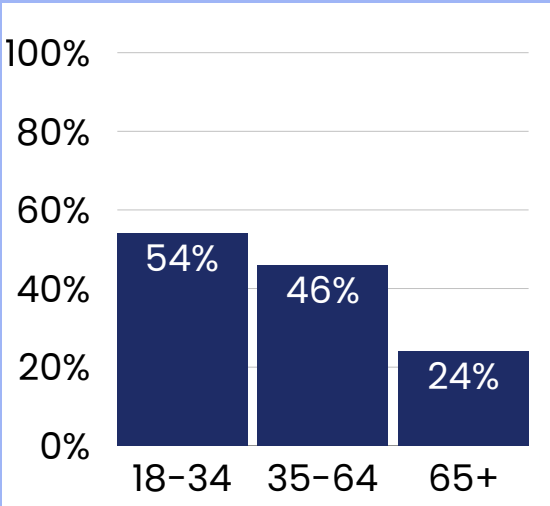
Some groups of people know more about PrEP than others.

87% of non-cisgender people,
82% of people with a recent STI,
79% of gay and bisexual men,
79% of sex workers
know that PrEP can prevent HIV.

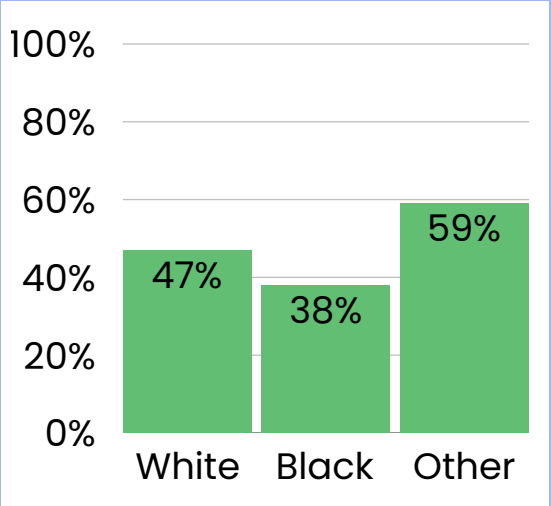
PrEP awareness varies by age, race, gender, and sexuality.

How can we help more people learn about PrEP for HIV prevention?

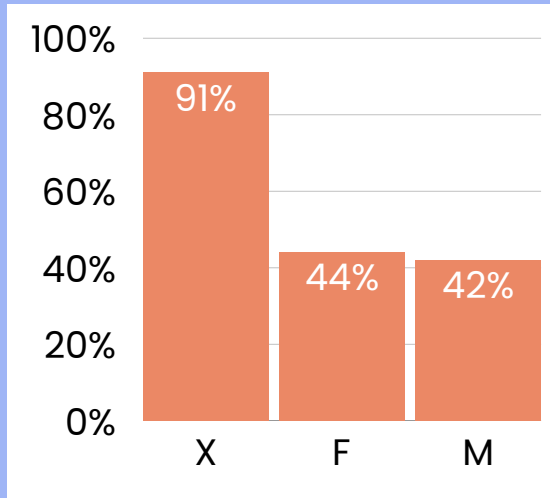
Age



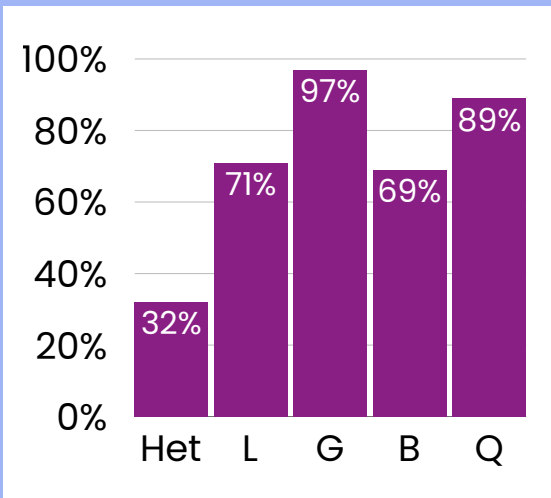
Race

Other groups of people know less about PrEP.

32% of heterosexual people,
37% of Hispanic/Latino people,
44% of women,
50% of immigrants and refugees,
54% of people who inject drugs
know that PrEP can prevent HIV.
